All guests enjoyed a smorgasbord of freshly prepared hamburgers and tacos and delectable sides including macaroni and cheese, baked beans, and mashed potatoes. The delicious desserts were peach cobbler and apple, sweet potato, and pecan pie. A DJ was spinning festive holiday tunes while people ate, and children enjoyed activities such as card making and face painting. Each child also received a toy drive gift to take home.
